Common Safety Precautions to Consider Following a Storm

- Jacksonville Sheriff's Office advises all residents to stay off the roads if possible
- Treat any non-functioning traffic signal as a four-way stop
- Do not cross flooded roadways, avoid standing water
- If your power is out, turn all appliances off that may have been in use
- If using a generator, insure proper air circulation to **avoid carbon monoxide poisoning**
- Conserve refrigerated air and be careful of **food spoilage**
- Be careful while assessing the damage of your property
- Use extreme caution while using a chainsaw
- Stay away from any downed power lines
